The Roy Williams Safety Net Foundation has implemented numerous programs designed to help selected families and children from low to moderate income single mother households to reach their goals. Mothers are carefully selected for the year long program, based on their need, and their willingness to put forth the effort necessary to improve their current standing. Program participants take part in monthly workshops that are based on a carefully selected curriculum designed to address a variety of topics that are important when striving to reach and maintain self-sufficiency. Three of these programs are Commitment to Excellence, the All Pro Club, and month community service activities.



Commitment to Excellence

The Commitment to Excellence (CTE) program is the fundamental initiative of The Roy Williams Safety Net Foundation. This program was established to empower the mothers that we serve to accomplish their goals, whether they be educational, professional or personal. Mothers participate in monthly workshops, and are afforded use of computer labs and tutoring at The RWSNF office.

All Pro Club

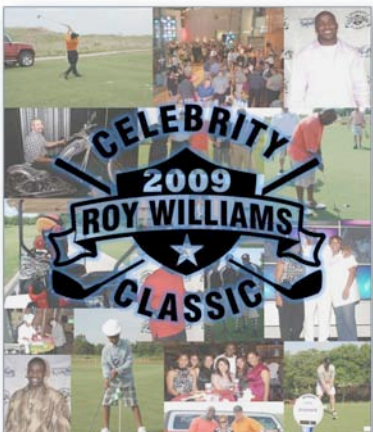
